From the dawn of history, the Himalayas with their overwhelming grandeur have remained an object of wonder veneration for Indians. Most people think that there is something divine about them. The Himalayas have figured prominently in the ancient and modern cultural history of India. For

thousands of years, from the time of Ashoka, Buddhist scholars travelled between India and the countries of Central Asia, like Tibet and China across the Himalayas to spread their religion of love and peace.

Geographically, the Himalayas have stood as a guard over India. But in view of modern means of communication, they have come to have a new importance. Our climate is affected by the mountains. The high mountains stops the rain clouds coming from the southern seas and cause heavy rains on the Indian plains. They also protect us from icy winds coming from the Arctic region which sweep over Siberia and Central Asia.
